

# Derek Nash Masterclass and Concert

## Terms and Conditions

The Masterclass is being promoted in good faith by Richard Woodling and is aimed to introduce saxophonists to different playing styles and improvisation. It is not necessary to play to a high standard. You should be comfortable with your instrument, know the notes on your instrument and be able to make a reasonable sound. There is no guarantee as to what you will learn and how much you will learn. The nature of the course like many things is that the more you put into it the more you will get out of it. Depending on your experience and exposure to different playing styles you will get more or less out of the day accordingly.

Payment for the Masterclass is to be made in full in advance by cheque. This payment is non-refundable except if the event is cancelled due to circumstances outside of the promoter's direct control. All efforts will be made to ensure the event goes ahead even if that means a change of venue or tutor at short notice. Any changes will be communicated as soon as they are known to the students. As such it is important that all those attending have provided accurate contact details so changes can be communicated. These details can be given on the [booking form](#).

The evening concert is included in the cost of the Masterclass for all students. If you are unable to attend the Masterclass there will not be a refund for the price of the Concert.

If you suffer from any illness or disability that may require specialist medical skills to be close to hand or you feel could present the Masterclass with some challenges then it is your duty to inform the promoter before attending the event. Details of all allergies and dietary needs will be provided on the [booking form](#) in advance.

Where special allergy or dietary needs have been declared in advance, we will inform the caterer. If the needs cannot be met we will inform the student in advance.

Your instruments and possessions will be your responsibility. No liability will be accepted for any damage however caused whilst at the venue either in the teaching room or in transit between the teaching room and the student's chosen mode of transport to and from the venue.

At all times students will behave appropriately which means not dominating or disrupting the session, swearing, making inappropriate or racist comments, committing acts of violence or demonstrating inappropriate behaviour. Failure to conform will mean instant expulsion from the class and if deemed appropriate the authorities may be informed.

You will respect the venue property and will report any damage caused immediately to the promoter or venue staff.

You may take photographs / video at the event and make recordings for personal use providing it does not unduly disrupt the event. If anyone objects to having their photo / video taken this will be respected.
